

Proposal for a Euromech Colloquium

The topic of a Euromech Colloquium should be of current research interest, and of such breadth as will attract about 50 qualified participants of whom at least 50 per cent should be from outside the host country. The proposer should normally be willing to act as Chairperson of the Colloquium, or as Co-chairperson with one or two others. Also, he or she should agree to carry out the duties laid down in the document 'Euromech Colloquia'. The Euromech Council meets each year in April, and considers all proposals for Colloquia to be held in the two subsequent years.
